## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

- It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
- All applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the EPA registered label are to be followed.
- This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

## **CROP**

Rice

## **USE RATE**

- PERMIT may be used as a late season application to rice at 1-1.3 oz/A plus 1% v/v of crop oil concentrate or .25% v/v of NIS for seed head suppression of escaped hemp sesbania and Northern joint vetch.
- Total application rate must not exceed 1.3 ounce of product by weight (0.062 lb. active ingredient) per acre per use season.
- With all foliar applications of PERMIT use a minimum 3-15 gallons of water per acre for aerial equipment and a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre for ground equipment. It is best to apply spray solutions the day they are mixed. Note: See "APPLICATION EQUIPMENT AND INSTRUCTIONS" section for spray drift management techniques.
- Do not apply within 48 days of harvest.
