**DRY BEANS - Cicer arietinum (chickpea, garbanzo bean); Lupinus spp. (including sweet lupine, white sweet lupine, white lupine, and grain lupine); Phaseolus spp. (including kidney bean, lima bean, mung bean, navy bean, pinto bean, snap bean, and waxbean); Vicia faba (broad bean, fava bean); Vigna spp. (including asparagus bean, blackeyed pea and cowpea)** (Does not include soybean)

Sonalan HFP - Alone

Apply and incorporate Sonalan HFP in the spring after planting and before emergence. Follow Soil Preparation, Application, Timing and Soil Incorporation Procedures sections of this label.

medium	3 1/2 - 4
